Other great news from Outpatient is that we had 132 visits in the month of July, making our YTD revenue \$5.9M, which is \$1.8M over last year.

As you all know, Dr. Peterson will be leaving HCHS in the next few weeks. With that being said, we currently don't have a replacement for him yet, but we're working on it. We've been working with Kearney Regional Medical Center and now RuralMed, with hopes of recruiting a new physician soon. However, we most likely won't have someone here until after the first of the new year. Stay tuned for more on this.

Lastly, thank you all for your continued dedication to HCHS. We have come a long way from when I first started last year and I'm very proud of all of our accomplishments. Let's continue to push through and make this the best year yet!


